NATURAL RESOURCES DEPARTMENT HISTORIC PRESERVATION PROGRAM APPROVE UNIVERSITY OF IDAHO SQIGWTS CLIMATE CHANGE PROJECT

CDA RESOLUTION 136 (2015)

WHEREAS, the Coeur d'Alene Tribal Council has been empowered to act for and on behalf of the Coeur d'Alene Tribe pursuant to the revised Constitution and By-Laws, adopted by the Coeur d'Alene Tribe by referendum November 10, 1984, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior, Bureau of Indian Affairs, December 21, 1984; and

WHEREAS, the Coeur d'Alene Tribe has a responsibility for the Health, Welfare, and Economic Development of the Tribe and its members, and for the protection and perpetuation of its intellectual property and traditional knowledge; and

WHEREAS, the University of Idaho has entered into an agreement with the Tribe that seeks to protect the intellectual property and traditional knowledge of the Coeur d'Alene Tribe, specifying that no information derived from this project, determined to be "confidential information," will be disseminated to the public without prior approval of the Coeur d'Alene Tribal Council; and

WHEREAS, this study, as determined by the Coeur d'Alene Tribe's Culture Committee, focused on the traditional knowledge and practice associated with *sqigwts* (water potato), to provide educational and research opportunities that relate to climate change; and

WHEREAS, the Coeur d'Alene Tribe's Historic Preservation Program provided coordination and facilitation for this collaborative project, in association with the Coeur d'Alene Tribe's Natural Resources and Culture Committees, who have reviewed and approved this project for public dissemination, removing its "confidential information" designation; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Coeur d'Alene Tribal Council hereby removes the "confidential information" status associated with the Sqigwts Climate Change project, and approves the project for public dissemination, to be used for non-profit educational purposes and research related to climate change.
